
“Empty Tombs, Upper Rooms” Acts 1:1-14

“The first account I composed...about all that Jesus began to do and teach, until the day when He was taken up, after He had by the Holy Spirit given orders to the apostles...”
Acts 1:1

“...Jesus commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised...” Acts 1:4

→ Jesus did not drop **the mic**.

- *“...all that Jesus began to do and teach...”* Acts 1:1

→ Jesus handed the mic to **His church**.

→ Jesus commanded His disciples **to wait**.

- *“...Jesus commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised...”* Acts 1:4

→ In the Upper Room, the Disciples waited **in prayer**.

- *“These all with one mind were continually devoting themselves to prayer...”* Acts 1:14

→ Prayer is **kingdom-critical**.

→ The Holy Spirit is **mission-critical**.

- *“You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you and you shall be My witnesses...”* Acts 1:8

→ Has Holy Spirit **dropped the mic?**

- It’s hard to have the same results as the early church, when we value a **Book** they did not have above **the Holy Spirit** that they did have.

→ If we’ve got the mic, we **need the Spirit**.

Clarifying Our Convictions:

→ Jesus did not **drop the mic**.

→ The Holy Spirit did not **drop the mic**.

→ The more Spirit-filled I am, the more I will look **like Jesus**.
