“You know Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and how He went about doing good, and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.” ... Acts 10:38

→ What I read in the Bible should
challenge me.

“...they discussed what they might do with Jesus” Luke 6:11

→ Jesus is both fully **human** and **divine.**

“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God and the Word was God.” John 1:1

“And the Word became flesh...” John 1:14

→ Jesus entered into a **voluntary agreement**
with His Father.

“He [Jesus] had equal status with God...but when the time came, He set aside the privileges of deity and ...became flesh.”
Philippians 2:6

→ Peter **summarized** Jesus’ ministry.

→ Jesus was **filled** with the Spirit. (Luke 3:21)

→ Jesus was **led** by the Spirit. (Luke 4:1)

→ Jesus was **empowered** by the Spirit. (Luke 4:14-16)

→ Jesus is not only the **Anointed** but the **Anointer**.

- *“He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit..” Mt 3:11*

→ We are in a **Luke 6** moment.

→ If we’ve got the mic, we **need the Spirit**.

Action Points:

- 1) Get into the **secret place** and cry out for God’s Spirit to have more of me.
- 2) Give the Spirit permission to **do anything** He wants with me.
- 3) Give the Spirit permission to **remove** any idea/theology that is not from Him.
- 4) Be willing to act **immediately** on His whispers or promptings.
