*“So the man of God was angry with [the king] and said,
“You should have...”* 2 Kings 13:19

→Got **regrets**?

→If you’ve got a **pulse**, you’ve got **regrets**.

→Some regrets only **bruise**; while others are **devastating**.

Elisha gives the king **four commands**.

“Take a bow and arrows...Open the window toward the east...Shoot!”
2 Kings 13:15-17

→After Elisha’s **declaration** comes a final **command**.

“And he said to the king of Israel, ‘Strike the ground!’ and he struck the ground three times and stopped.” 2 Kings 13:18

→Most Christians who feel stuck aren't **stuck**, they've **stopped**.

→The only people God cannot use are **half-hearted** people.
