#### "Living a Regret-Free Life"

"So the man of God was angry with [the king] and said, "You should have..." 2 Kings 13:19

#### →Got<u>regrets</u>?

 $\rightarrow$ If you've got a **<u>pulse</u>**, you've got **<u>regrets</u>**.

## →Some regrets only <u>bruise</u>; while others are <u>devastating</u>.

#### Elisha gives the king four commands.

"Take a bow and arrows...Open the window toward the east...Shoot!" 2 Kings 13:15-17

# →After Elisha's <u>declaration</u> comes a final <u>command</u>.

"And he said to the king of Israel, 'Strike the ground!' and he struck the ground three times and stopped." 2 Kings 13:18 →Most Christians who feel stuck aren't <u>stuck</u>, they've <u>stopped</u>.
