

"Wonder Management"

"Joshua said to them, 'Cross again to ... the middle of the Jordan, and each of you take up a stone on his shoulder...'" Joshua 4:5

Just like God promised, He did <u>a wonder</u> among His people.

We are called upon not just to experience God's wonders, but to <u>manage</u> them.

Three words to leaders:
